

LAKE BLUFF

Deluxe Sleeper - Stabled at Council Bluffs

The *Lake Bluff* was built by Pullman Standard for the Kansas City Southern Railway in 1965 as coach No. 272.

The coach was sold to the New Jersey Department of Transportation in 1972 and renumbered No. 5342. The Chicago & North Western acquired it in 1986 and renamed it No. 413, *Lake Bluff*.

The *Lake Bluff* was an eight-bedroom sleeper and became part of Union Pacific's Heritage Passenger Fleet as the result of the 1995 Union Pacific and C&NW merger. It was reconfigured as a deluxe four-bedroom sleeper in 2008.



Configuration: Lake Bluff is a Sleeper Car featuring four, two-room suites. The rooms are connected by the private bathroom. (Sleeps four guests)
