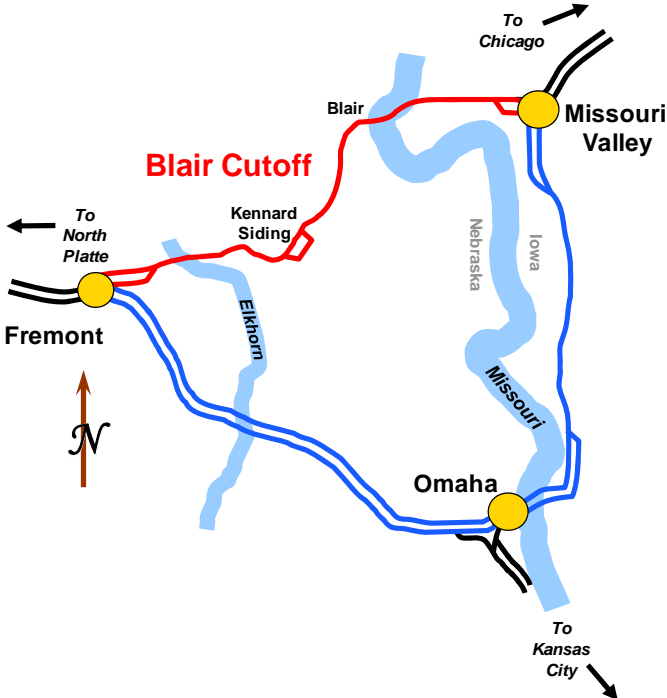


# Blair Subdivision Double Track Project Fast Facts.



- Multi-year \$300 million investment
- Construction will include:
  - 29 miles of new double track between Fremont, Neb., and Missouri Valley, Iowa
  - New bridges -- Missouri River east of Blair and Elkhorn River near Arlington, Neb.
  - Several support tracks at Fremont and Missouri Valley
- It is 25 miles shorter for trains operating between Fremont and Missouri Valley, Iowa, to take the Blair Sub., than to operate from Fremont to

Council Bluffs, Iowa, and then north to Missouri Valley.

- When the Blair Subdivision is complete, each train going between Fremont and Missouri Valley will save two to four hours operating over the Blair route instead of going from Fremont to Council Bluffs to Missouri Valley.
- About 130 employees and contractors will work on the multi-year project.
- 11 acres of land was donated to Pheasants Forever to support area conservation efforts.
