

Always expect a train.

TRAINS ARE QUIET.

Stop, look and really listen before crossing the tracks. Roll down your window as an extra precaution.

Always stop at a railroad crossing when the arm is down or lights are flashing. And never try to beat a train.

TRAINS CAN'T STOP SUDDENLY TO AVOID HITTING YOU.

A train can take a full mile to stop. Just because an engineer sees you, it doesn't mean you're safe.

KEEP YOUR REAR CLEAR.

Make sure that your truck's landing gear clears crossings and that your trailer completely clears the tracks.

ALWAYS EXPECT A TRAIN.

When you're near railroad tracks, act as if there's a train headed your way – because there might be.
