In order to encourage model railroad hobbyists, Union Pacific has created two payment options for licensees in the model railroad industry. These options are available only for model railroad equipment sold primarily to hobbyists. Licensee applicants who produce Union Pacific-branded products sold primarily as toys must fill out the standard licensee application and are not eligible for these payment options. If you are not sure whether your product should be classified as a toy or a hobbyist item, please contact Union Pacific.

## Option 1

A royalty of three percent is payable on any product bearing a modern, historic, or constituent logo licensed by Union Pacific. The licensee will pay an advance on royalties based on the wholesale price of the product(s) and estimated annual sales of UP-branded products.

#### Option 2

An annual fee of .5 percent (one half of one percent) of <u>total</u> licensee gross sales of all model railroad products will be paid to Union Pacific. Gross sales will be calculated on the most recent completed year of sales and will be based on an audited financial report. Licensee applicants with gross sales in excess of \$1 million should contact Union Pacific for additional information.

Option 2 is based on the assumption that Union Pacific-branded merchandise comprises roughly 20 percent of average industry sales; licensee applicants whose Union Pacific-branded inventory comprises less than 20 percent may want to consider selecting Option 1.
