

E-Clips and E-Track Usage

E-Track

E-Track equipment extends approximately 6 ft. from the doors in 53 ft. and approx. 3.5 ft. in 48 ft. equipment.







2x6 lumber is installed into the track hardware and placed against the cargo to restrain the pallets from any longitudinal movement.
