- Add one day to Monday-Saturday schedule for cars released on Sunday.
- Destinations not listed are subject to individual review.
- For shipments originating in north central or western Oregon and Washington, add two (2) days to above destinations. For shipments originating in Nevada and Utah, add three (3) days to above destinations.
- Add two days transit for cars released November 12, 2023, through November 25, 2023 (Thanksgiving Holiday).
- Cars released after Friday, December 1, 2023, Union Pacific will consider responsibility for product deterioration as a result of time on a case-by-case basis, providing a USDA product inspection was completed within 24 hrs of rail car loading and unloading. Claims consideration will be for transit delays of more than 7 days past the published transit time.

For claims filed, USDA inspections are required from origin and destination. All claims are reviewed on its own merit.

- Union Pacific will not be responsible for product deterioration due to temperature variance when rail car temperature gauges and/or refrigeration unit control computer indicate the temperature was maintained between plus and/or minus (5) degrees Fahrenheit of the requested unit set temperature.
- Union Pacific reserves the right, at their discretion, to further amend this liability provision at any time.
